

### **DESCRIPTION**

“Carparo” is a calcareous stone coming from Puglia. Depending on extraction areas, it can have different compositions: from a rough composition to a closer one. It has good technical features even if a tuff. It can reach a resistance to compression of 70 Kg/cmq.

### **USE**

For its good resistance to erosion, carparo can be used to build houses without further plastering. At the same time it is used to decorate too.

With its yellow color it enriches the atmospheres, making also big spaces warm.

Carparo balustrades, frames, handrails, basements, pillars, arches and capitals are only some of the works used to decorate public and private buildings.
